

Becoming a Member of Jet Cities

Attend at least three (3) consecutive Jet Cities rehearsals.



Decide which song to audition with.

You can pick one of our two contest songs. If neither is available, please ask someone on the Music Team which songs in our current repertoire would be appropriate for an audition.



Decide how you would like to audition:

- A. During rehearsal, you will step off of the risers and to the side, holding a recording device. As the chorus sings through the song, you will sing from your position into the recording device. You must have the music memorized. Your recording will be reviewed later.
- B. Before or after rehearsal, you will meet with the Music Team. The section leaders will form a quartet. You will stand in for your section leader, representing your voice part. As a member of this quartet, you will sing through the song. You must have the music memorized. Members of the Music Team will listen to your audition.



Inform our current Membership Chair. Let her know your song choice and how you would like to audition.



Our current Membership Chair will work with you and the Music Team to determine when you will audition.



Audition!



The Music Team will evaluate your audition based on your ability to memorize and sing correct notes, words, rhythms with a consistent and free tone.



You passed!



The Music Team will recommend to the Management Team that you should become a Member. The Management Team will vote.



The Membership Chair will inform you that you passed! In the next couple of weeks during rehearsal, we will inform the chorus, give you an official name tag, and welcome you to our chorus with a song.



You didn't pass.



The Music Team will give you feedback on your audition. Your section leader may offer to work with you. Then, you can audition again.

Frequently Asked Questions

What experience do I need and do I need to be able to read music to join?

All are welcome. We provide many learning tools, so you do not need any prior musical experience and you do not need to be able to read music.

What resources are available to help me learn my music?

As a prospective member, you will have access to our private chorus website where we keep all documents, learning tracks, and sheet music. You can also come to rehearsals where we work on the music each week. Finally, if you would like extra practice, you can ask the section leader or someone else in your section to help you.

How much does membership cost?

Membership dues are paid once a month at \$40. The first payment is \$176. Your first month's dues are broken up as follows: \$40 for regular monthly chorus dues, \$36 for regional dues, and \$100 for international dues.

How can I pay for my membership?

You can set up autopay with our Finance Chair or bring cash (in an envelope with your name) or a check (with your name on it) to rehearsal and put it in the membership dues box.

Where do your membership dues go?

Your membership dues are used for chorus operations such as music purchase, rehearsal rental space, education classes at contest, director's salary, etc.
